Mayor Sutton called the meeting to order with the announcement that the meeting had been advertised, that it was being electronically recorded and meeting was being held in full compliance of the Open Public Meeting Act.

Mayor Sutton asked everyone to stand and join the committee in the Flag Salute and Lord's Prayer.

Mayor Sutton said called upon Lt. Horsey, of the NJ State Police.

Lt. Horsey said he would like to inform the committee of what has been going on at the barracks and stated during February 2017, there were 160 motor vehicle stops, 126 property checks, 4 motor vehicle accidents, there were some lawn chairs stolen from a property and a new \$70,000 Backhoe stolen from Crown Rite, that was doing work in the lake area. He said they retrieved the backhoe by officers going up in a helicopter. It was stolen by two brothers and found in Pittsgrove Township. Lt. Horsey said just a reminder that all residents need to keep their dwellings locked, their garages, sheds, toolshed, etc., and put everything up and locked up. Lt. Horsey said one more issue, there are counterfeit bills being spent, none is Commercial so far, but they have appeared in Maurice River Township, so be careful where you get one hundred dollar bills from.

Mayor Sutton thanked Lt. Horsey and said next items are the minutes. Mayor said we cancelled the agenda meeting on February 14, 2017, we had one meeting in February which was:

A motion was made and seconded to approve minutes with a unanimous roll call vote.

Mayor Sutton said next item is the Bill List for the month of March 2017 as prepared by Chief Financial Officer, Pam Humphries.

A motion was made and seconded to approve payment of bills for March 2017 with a unanimous roll call vote.

Mayor Sutton said we have a letter from George & Verna Plitnik, Tampa, Florida, they want to donate property that they have owned for years and at this point no intentions in using It. Block 108, Lots 8384, 8385,8386,8387, 80X100, known as 322 Satinwood Road, Laurel Lake. Plitnik's were informed that township requires \$600 on a land donation to help cover legal fees in title search, deed preparations and recording of deed at county level.

Committee made motion and second to accept the land donation and authorized solicitor to finalize donation. Roll call vote, unanimous.

Mayor Sutton said we have a letter from Reverend Anthony E. Elliott, Sr. Apostolic Lighthouse Church in Millville. Reverend Elliott has submitted a bid of \$5,000 for Block 16, Lots 4186 through 4193, 153X88 known as 7501 Battle Lane, Laurel Lake.

Committee made motion and second to accept bid and told clerk to schedule a land sale for the April 20, 2017 meeting. Roll call vote, unanimous.

Mayor Sutton said we were offered \$200 for Block 122, Lots 9390,9391, 40X100. Offer came from adjoining owner, it is an undersized lot, all adjoining owners were notified by certified mail of the sale and landsale was advertised two times within 14 days of sale. Mayor said we have a bid of \$200 for Block 122, Lot 9390,9391, is there any other bidder? Seeing and hearing none what is the pleasure of the committee.

Committeeman Vizzard made motion to sell property to Cindy Reynolds and Committeeman Jamison seconded the motion with a unanimous roll call vote.

Mayor Sutton said we have several resolutions and they will be read by title under Consent Resolution 2017-1.

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A.4-78b has authorized the Local Finance Board to adopt rules that permit municipalities in sound fiscal condition to assume the responsibility, normally granted to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, of conducting the annual budget examination; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-7 WAS ADOPTED BY THE Local Finance Board on February 11, 1997; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.2 THROUGH 7.5, THE Township of Commercial has been declared eligible to participate in the program by the Division of Local Government Services, and the Chief Financial Officer has determined that the local government meets the necessary conditions to participate in the program for the 2017 budget year.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the Township of Commercial that in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.6a & 7.6b and based upon the Chief Financial Officer's certification, the governing body has found the budget has met the following requirements:

- 1. That with reference to the following items, the amounts have been calculated pursuant to law and appropriated as such in the budget:
  - a. Payment of interest and debt redemption charges
  - b. Deferred charges and statutory expenditures
  - c. Cash deficit of preceding year
  - d. Reserve for uncollected taxes
  - e. Other reserves and non-disbursement items
  - f. Any inclusions of amounts required for school purposes
- 2. That the provisions relating to limitation on increases of appropriations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and appropriations for exceptions to limits on appropriations found at N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.3 et seq., are fully met (complies with CAP law)
- 3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and N.J.A.C. 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.
- 4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
  - a. All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate and correctly stated,
  - b. Items of appropriation are properly set forth.
  - In itemization, form, arrangement and content, the budget will permit the exercise if the comptroller functions within the municipality.
- 5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced and publicly advertised in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.
- 6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution will be forwarded to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services upon adoption.

One house is in Laurel Lake and one is in Port Norris, He said the one in Laurel Lake will be torn down on Monday and Port Norris house at a later date.

Mayor asked for motion to open meeting to the public.

Mayor Sutton stated Megan Wren, from Bivalve Center, would like to address the committee.

Mrs. Wren said this year is the 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Bay Day Celebration and that the Bivalve Center was hoping to do something special but they have relied on the county for financial support but this year the county was going to have to cut back about twenty-four hundred dollars and she had no choice but to approach the committee to see if the township could help them out this year. Mrs. Wren said in the beginning the township helped sponsor Bay Day by paying for the shuttles, the fireworks and programs for the kiddies, but the township had to meet some financial crises and step back. She said being their 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary they wanted to expand and bring in a mummers group for the parade, possibly a band, we will need the shuttle buses. Mrs. Wren stated that next time she will file for a grant with the state instead of just the county, it was too late for this years filing.

Committeeman asked Mrs. Wren of her shortfall.

Mayor Sutton, Committeemen Jamison and Vizzard felt that township could contribute \$4000 to the Bivalve Center for their 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Bay Day Celebration.

Mrs. Wren thanked the committee and asked if they would consider being in the parade on Saturday, June  $\mathbf{3}^{\text{rd}}$ .

Mayor Sutton asked for additional comments.

Mr. Russell Stormes, Coordinator of the Food Pantry said the they are expanding that they were given a lot of soaps, shampoos, conditioners, etc., that they are passing along to the people along with food. He said they are also accepting clean clothing and that individuals can go through it and take what their family needs.

Committeeman Vizzard said the electric bill for the Community Center was very high for one month and he assumes it is because of the number of freezers that have to be kept running. He said he would like to discuss with Mr. Stormes putting timer's on the freezers so they shut down in the evening, he said with no one opening the doors the contents of the freezers will not thaw.

Mr. Stormes said the requirements on the freezers are zero degrees and that there is a schedule that he goes buy posted. He suggested Committeeman Vizzard review it and see what they can come up with.

Mayor asked for additional comments and being none asked for motion to close public portion and to adjourn the meeting.
