ANJEC: Julie reported ANJEC will be co-hosting with the Pinelands Preservation Alliance and Medford Environmental Affairs Advisory Committee "Creek (and Lake!) Friendly Yards" on Wednesday May 29 from 7-8:30pm at Cranberry Hall in Medford. Admission is free.

ANJEC has been hosting press conferences in various towns to celebrate the passage of over 50 ordinances banning single use plastics.

Sustainable Jersey: Pat reported she and John submitted the application for the 165-point bronze re-certification. It was received and accepted by Sustainable Jersey.

Mission Statement: John distributed the revised statement. Motion to accept it was approved.

Business cards: John handed out our new business cards.
