### Acceptable Items for Single Stream CURBSIDE Recycling

Aluminum and Steel cans ~ Food & Beverage cartons ~ Bottles & Jars ~ Mixed paper, Newspapers & Magazines ~ flattened cardboard ~ Kitchen, Laundry, Bath Bottles & Containers

Rinse before placing in recycling container!
Food is one of the highest contaminants in our recycling stream today.

#### Paper-

All paper
Envelopes (with or without windows)
Cereal boxes
Cartons (juice, milk)
Junk mail
Magazines/Newspapers
Telephone books
Cardboard (Corrugated must be flattened)
Wrapping paper/tissue paper
Paperback or hardback books (covers removed)

#### Plastics-

Plastics #1 & #2 Soda/juice bottles Plastic food containers (food removed)

#### Glass -

All glass bottles/containers/jars

#### Metals -

Aluminum/Steel/Tin cans Empty aerosol cans (remove lids)

## Do not recycle at CURBSIDE!

Trash

Plastic bags

Shredded paper

Hazardous waste

Non-Recyclable plastics (Styrofoam)

Liquids in bottles or containers

Aluminum foil

Paper or plastic plates, towels & utensils

Plastic containers without a number

Non-Recyclable glass or ceramic (China/dishware/glassware/vases)

Pizza boxes are best left out of recycling bin due to food contamination

Broken glass or mirrors

Light bulbs

**Batteries** 

Wire clothes hangers

Pots & pans

Tire rims or car parts

Food waste or garbage

Syringes/Needles/Sharps
