## ***ZONE 3: JAMES MOORE AND ALL ROADS IN PORT NORRIS INCLUDING OSBORNE, COLOGNE, & TYSON TERRACE***

JAN: 12 & 26	FEB: 9 & 23	MAR: 9 & 23	APR: 6 & 20
MAY: 4 & 18	JUN: 1, 15 & 29	JUL: 13 & 27	AUG: 10 & 24
SEP: 7 & 21	OCT: 5 & 19	NOV: 2, 16 & 30	DEC: 14 & 28

## Acceptable Items for Single Stream CURBSIDE Recycling

*Aluminum and Steel cans ~ Food & Beverage cartons ~ Bottles & Jars ~ Mixed paper, Newspapers & Magazines ~ flattened cardboard ~ Kitchen, Laundry, Bath Bottles & Containers*

**Rinse before placing in recycling container!**  
**Food is one of the highest contaminants in our recycling stream today.**

### **Paper-**

All paper  
Envelopes (with or without windows)  
Cereal boxes  
Cartons (juice, milk)  
Junk mail  
Magazines/Newspapers  
Telephone books  
Cardboard (Corrugated must be flattened)  
Wrapping paper/tissue paper  
Paperback or hardback books (covers removed)

### **Plastics-**

Plastics #1 & #2  
Soda/juice bottles  
Plastic food containers (food removed)

### **Glass –**

All glass bottles/containers/jars

### **Metals –**

Aluminum/Steel/Tin cans  
Empty aerosol cans (remove lids)

## Do not recycle at CURBSIDE!

Trash	Broken glass or mirrors
Plastic bags	Light bulbs
Shredded paper	Batteries
Hazardous waste	Wire clothes hangers
Non-Recyclable plastics (Styrofoam)	Pots & pans
Liquids in bottles or containers	Tire rims or car parts
Aluminum foil	Food waste or garbage
Paper or plastic plates, towels & utensils	Syringes/Needles/Sharps
Plastic containers without a number	
Non-Recyclable glass or ceramic (China/dishware/glassware/vases)	
Pizza boxes are best left out of recycling bin due to food contamination
