ZONE 3: JAMES MOORE AND ALL ROADS IN PORT NORRIS INCLUDING OSBORNE, COLOGNE, & TYSON TERRACE

Acceptable Items for Single Stream CURBSIDE Recycling

Aluminum and Steel cans ~ Food & Beverage cartons ~ Bottles & Jars ~ Mixed paper, Newspapers & Magazines ~ flattened cardboard ~ Kitchen, Laundry, Bath Bottles & Containers

Rinse before placing in recycling container!

Food is one of the highest contaminants in our recycling stream today.

Paper-

All paper
Envelopes (with or without windows)
Cereal boxes
Cartons (juice, milk)
Junk mail
Magazines/Newspapers
Telephone books
Cardboard (Corrugated must be flattened)
Wrapping paper/tissue paper
Paperback or hardback books (covers removed)

Plastics-

Plastics #1 & #2
Soda/juice bottles
Plastic food containers (food removed)

Glass –

All glass bottles/containers/jars

Metals –

Aluminum/Steel/Tin cans
Empty aerosol cans (remove lids)

Do not recycle at CURBSIDE!

Trash	Broken glass or mirrors
Plastic bags	Light bulbs
Shredded paper	Batteries
Hazardous waste	Wire clothes hangers
Non-Recyclable plastics (Styrofoam)	Pots & pans
Liquids in bottles or containers	Tire rims or car parts
Aluminum foil	Food waste or garbage
Paper or plastic plates, towels & utensils	Syringes/Needles/Sharps
Plastic containers without a number	
Non-Recyclable glass or ceramic (China/dishware/glassware/vases)	
Pizza boxes are best left out of recycling bin due to food contamination
